With a community of over 200 students and 40 staff, Ilim College's Doveton Campus is a Prep – Year 11 co-educational campus. Formed in 2016, Doveton has educated young students to prepare them in academic, professional and social skills.

Our campus reflects Australia's rich cultural diversity, with 94% of our families speaking a language other than English.

A library, an assembly hall, art room, science lab, IT lab, a gymnasium, sporting fields, and a health-focused canteen are just the beginning. Our college is committed to developing classroom facilities that help achieve strong outcomes for all our students.

In 2023, our Campus will open the doors to the Stage 1 building of our masterplan. Comprising of 9 classrooms, a reception and office spaces, this building will also include a new playground for our lower primary students, as well as outdoor learning spaces.

All our Middle and Senior school students will be equipped with the best technological resources, including their own Apple laptop programmed with software ideal for their learning.

Experienced educators use a range of effective teaching methods to maintain consistent, successful results, in past and emerging students. Our teaching and learning, student services, business management and information technology departments provide a coordinated educational environment where each child can thrive.

Specialised Sub-Schools

In 2023, Doveton will be opening Junior, Middle and Senior Sub-Schools with specialist staff, including expert appointments for the Head and Deputy Head responsibilities of each sub-school. A student to staff ratio of 1:9 will allow for education with a focus on each individual students learning requirements.

Evidence based learning will be the main focus for our Junior School students from Prep to Grade 4. Our Middle School will include students from Grade 5 to Year 8, and a range of specialised programs to add to the academic journey of your child. The Senior School, Year 9 to VCE, will offer a comprehensive range of subjects and programs.

Offered VCE subjects will be all taught on-site in small class sizes: English, General Maths and Maths Methods, Computing, Biology, Chemistry, Psychology, History, Business Management, Arabic, Turkish and Text and Traditions.

Islamic Education and Hifz

Islam is at the centre of our approach to education. Students are introduced to the foundational teachings of Islam through an overview of the articles of faith and worship and Prophetic biography. Later in their education, students are further exposed to the finer details of faith, worship, and Holy Quran, glance at the history of Islam, and engage with contemporary issues relevant to Muslims living in the modern world.

Our Islamic Education Students commence their lifelong journey with the Quran from the moment they become part of our diverse family in Prep and build a firm relationship with it throughout their whole academic journey at the College.

The Hifz program is an accelerated Qur'an program supporting students who are interested and committed to memorising the Holy Qur'an in less than three years. Intake for the programs classes starts from Grade 1. It is for students who excel in Qur'an and Islamic studies, as well as achieving consistently successful results across all subjects.

Student support services

Our student services team offers nursing, psychology, speech pathology and education support professionals led by the department head. All work together to ensure students achieve their full academic and social potential and, importantly, believe in themselves.

We also offer a multitude of programs that address academic and social challenges, mental health and wellbeing. We are there to provide crucial support for issues your child may face. This includes class-based and one-on-one support, or resources to improve your child's study habits.
